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**HOW TO PREPARE:**  
Mix this product with clean water. Use only plastic lined plastic, brass, copper, fibreglass, aluminium, or stainless steel containers for mixing and application. DO NOT mix more than can be used within 5 days. Wash out spray equipment thoroughly after use.

**CAUTION:**
