David Grays UREA

Used regularly, David Grays Urea will improve the quality of citrus, apple and stone fruits and will also quickly green up lawns. David Grays Urea can be used neat (straight from the pack), or, because it is 100% soluble, applied by watering can or irrigation systems.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Citrus:

For each medium size tree, dissolve 50 grams of David Grays Urea in 10 litres of water. Apply monthly from September to April.

Lawns:

Quickly "greens up" all types of lawns by applying David Grays Urea at a rate of 40 grams per square metre of lawn. Water in well.

Stonefruit:

For apples and stonefruit dissolve 25 grams of David Grays Urea, 5 litres of water and apply 4-5 times to each tree between bud swell, and up to 6 weeks after fruiting.

Warning:

Scorching will occur if neat fertiliser comes in contact with wet leaves. Always water in fertiliser immediately after application.

When used in liquid form, take care not to make the solution any stronger than 5 grams per litre of water. For indoor and sensitive plants do not use more than 1 gram per litre of water.

Note - One small handful equals approximately 40 grams
