How to Use:	<p>HOW TO USE ANTEX INSECTICIDE BAIT:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Separate the 4 bait stations. No activation needed, they are ready for immediate use. For thorough ant control, use all four bait stations at the same time.</li><li>2. Do not remove baits from bait station or sticker from back of baits.</li><li>3. Place each bait station indoors right next to ant trails or close to areas where ants are numerous.</li><li>4. Four Double-sided adhesives (4 pack) or six double-sided adhesives (6 pack) are enclosed to stick baits to walls or underneath benches.</li><li>5. Avoid spraying other insecticides on or around the bait stations.</li><li>6. Initially, ant activity may increase but this will ease as worker ants take the bait back to the nest.</li><li>7. Do not interfere with the ants or the bait stations during use.</li><li>8. Ensure that all areas are free from food particles.</li><li>9. For continuous control of ants, replace the bait stations after 3 months of use or shorter if baits have been consumed.</li></ol>

How to Prepare:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Ant eats Bait</li> <li>2. Takes food back and infects the ants</li> <li>3.
