HOW TO USE:

DO NOT use in windy conditions. Minimise spray drift by using low pressures and nozzles, which do not give a fine droplet. **DO NOT** allow spray drift onto desirable vegetation. **DO NOT** contaminate water used for gardens and domestic use on dams, rivers or streams. **DO NOT** burn off, cut or clear blackberry for 6 months after treatment.

SITUATION	STATES	RATE	HOW TO APPLY
To Control: Blackberry	All States	100ml in 12 litres of water	Apply from late spring to early autumn when bushes are growing actively. Spray to wet all leaves and stems thoroughly. Regrowth and seedlings should be sprayed after hardening off
To Control: Eucalypt, Wattle Seedlings, Suckers, Woody Weeds – up to 5cm basal diameter		100ml on 1.2 litres of kerosene	Spray or paint stems from ground level to 30cm height wetting thoroughly
Stump Spraying			Spray or paint on freshly cut stems of suckers and seedlings more than 5cm in diameter after cutting stems or trunks to within 15cm of the ground

CLEANING OF EQUIPMENT:

After use clean equipment thoroughly with soap and water and rinse several times prior to reuse.

Discharge washing's on non-cropland away from water supply.

Equipment that has been used for application of Blackberry & Tree Killer should not be used for application of other materials to sensitive plants.

STORAGE and DISPOSAL:

Store in the closed original container in a cool dry place out of the reach of children. Do not store in direct sunlight. Dispose of empty container by wrapping in paper, placing in a plastic bag and putting in garbage.
