**HOW TO USE: SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE.**

- Avoid spraying under windy or hot conditions, or when plants are dry and suffering from moisture stress.
- DO NOT spray outdoors if rain is expected within 24 hours.

PLANTS	PESTS	HOW TO APPLY
Citrus, shrubs, roses, ornamentals, indoor plants.	Red, white wax and certain other scales (not San Jose Scale), sooty mould, mealybugs, spider mites, aphids, white fly (not QLD, NT or ACT), white louse scale (QLD only).	Spray lightly onto affected plants and ensure that all areas are covered, including undersides of foliage. Hold can at least 15cm from plant. Spray in a sweeping motion so as to cover at least one metre every 5 seconds.

As a leaf gloss on indoor plants, clean leaves first with a damp cloth, then apply lightly and evenly to the upper surface of hard leaved plants only. Spraying too close may cause a chilling of the plant.

**WITHHOLDING PERIOD: DO NOT PICK EDIBLE CROPS FOR 1 DAY AFTER SPRAYING.**

- DO NOT USE UNTIL 4 WEEKS AFTER A SULPHUR SPRAY. Avoid spraying directly onto flowers, bromeliads or palms. DO NOT use on citrus trees in late autumn or winter.
